

2010 VOTING OPPORTUNITIES

EARLY VOTING – MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

PRIMARY ELECTION DAY - AUGUST 24, 2010

New registrations and party changes must be submitted by July 26, 2010

EARLY VOTING PERIOD: August 9 through August 21 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

GENERAL ELECTION DAY – NOVEMBER 2, 2010

New registrations must be submitted by October 4, 2010

EARLY VOTING PERIOD: October 18 through October 30 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

All registered Nassau County voters may vote at **any** of the early voting sites listed below. Please remember to bring your photo and signature identification with you to the polling place. If you do not have the required identification, you may vote a provisional ballot. Voter Information Cards **may not** be used for identification.

VOTE BY MAIL (ABSENTEE) BALLOT

Any registered voter may vote by mail (no reason required). Ballots may be requested in person, by phone, fax, mail or on-line at www.votenassau.com. Ballots are available approximately 30 days prior to the election. The voter's name, residence address, date of birth and signature or mark (written requests only) must be provided when making the request. Please contact our office for more information.

You may track your ballot status by visiting our free access system at www.votenassau.com. From the *Voter Information* menu on the left side of the home page, select *My Voter Information* and complete the required fields to access your information. If you do not have Internet access, or if you have questions about mail ballot voting, please contact our office.

ELECTION DAY

Polling places are open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. You may cast your ballot using the optical scan voting equipment at your assigned polling place location. All polling places are accessible to persons with disabilities and are equipped with accessible voting equipment.

If you do not know your precinct and polling place location, please refer to your Voter Information Card, visit our website and select *My Voter Information*, or call our office. **Please be advised that it is against the law to knowingly vote outside of the precinct in which you live.**

Voting assistance is available to any voter who requires assistance to vote. The voter may request the assistance of two election officials or some other person of his/her own choice to assist him/her in casting his/her vote. (F.S. 97.061; F.S. 101.051; Voting Rights Act, Section 208) Persons with disabilities requiring accommodations in order to participate in the election process should contact the Supervisor of Elections office at any of the numbers below:
